

How to Create an IRS Account for Form 8821 – Halcyon Within Xactus360

1. It is recommended that the borrower have an account with the IRS prior to submitting the order for the fastest turnaround time. If the borrower does not have an account, one can be setup prior to your order by clicking the link on the left-hand side under Resources.



2. This link will take you to irs.gov to begin the sign-in process. Click 'Sign in to your account'.



3. Select 'New to online account? Get started'.

5. Choose 'Create an account'.

Sign In or Create a New Account	
You only need one ID.me account If you already have an account, don't create a new one. You can use the same ID.me account to sign in to different IRS online services.	
IRS now offers a sign-in option with ID.me, which offers access to IRS online services with a secure account that protects your privacy. ID.me is an account created, maintained, and secured by a technology provider. If you don't have an ID.me account, you must create a new account.

6. Enter your email address and password, then check the box to accept the ID.me Terms of Service. When all is complete, click 'Create account'.

7. Click 'Continue'.

CONTINUING TO THE INTERNAL REVENUE SERVICE

To protect your identity and information from fraudulent actors, your authentication and transactionrelated data (the information related to your ID.me account and identity verification) will be shared with the IRS. This helps ensure that it is really you interacting with the website and not someone pretending to be you.

This information includes transaction-related data like the following:

- Prior sign-ins using your ID.me account (but the names of the websites you access would not be disclosed)
- Multi-factor authentication methods (e.g., text message or push notification)
- The status of your verification (e.g., what steps you have or have not completed; partially entered information)

If you choose not to continue, you will not be able to use your ID.me account to access IRS.

8. Check your email for a 6-digit confirmation code. Enter the code and click 'Confirm code'.

9. Choose a multi-factor authentication (MFA) option and authenticate yourself using the option you chose. Upon completion, continue to the next step.



10. Next, select a method to verify your identity and click 'Continue'.



11. Read the consent information and check the acknowledgement box. Then, click 'Continue'.

 - c. Use your phone camera to take a video selfie
 - d. Enter your Social Security Number
 - e. Review your information

14. You will receive confirmation of your complete identity verification process and you are not ready to login through the IRS Sign-In page.
